

CEDAR COUNTY REDISTRICTING & REPRECINCTING ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REDISTRICTING AND REPRECINCTING OF CEDAR COUNTY FROM THE 2000 CENSUS AS REQUIRED BY IOWA CODE [49.3(4), 331.209-331.210A]

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Cedar County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE: The purpose of this ordinance is to establish election precincts for Cedar County to comply with current laws due to the 2000 federal decennial census.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS: For use in this ordinance, the following terms or words shall be interpreted or defined as follows:

1. "Voting Precinct" or "Precinct" shall mean a county or municipal subdivision for casting and counting votes in elections.
2. "Township" shall mean a civil and political subdivision of the county.

SECTION 3. ELECTION PRECINCTS: Cedar County shall have thirteen (13) election precincts established and defined as follows:

PRECINCT NAME

Cass/Red Oak -	All of Cass Township and all of Red Oak Township
Center -	All of Center Township
Dayton/Fairfield -	All of Dayton Township and all of Fairfield Township and including the City of Clarence
Farmington -	All of Farmington Township, including the City of Durant
Fremont -	All of Fremont Township, including the City of Stanwood
Gower/Springdale-	All of Gower Township and all of Springdale Township, including the City of West Branch (portion that is located in Cedar County)
Inland -	All of Inland Township, including the City of Bennett
Iowa/Rochester/Sugar Creek-	All of Iowa Township, all of Rochester Township, and all of Sugar Creek Township, including City of Wilton (portion that is located in Cedar County)
Linn/Pioneer -	All of Linn Township, and Pioneer Township, including the City of Mechanicsville
Massillon/Springfield -	All of Massillon Township and Springfield Township, including the City of Lowden
Tipton 1 -	City of Tipton – Ward #1, per Ordinance 424
Tipton 2 -	City of Tipton – Ward #2, per Ordinance 424
Tipton 3 -	City of Tipton – Ward #3, per Ordinance 424

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective on January 15, 2002, after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
