

CEDAR COUNTY REDISTRICTING & REPRECINCTING ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REDISTRICTING AND REPRECINCTING OF CEDAR COUNTY FROM THE 2010 CENSUS AS REQUIRED BY IOWA CODE [49.3(4), 331.209-331.210A]

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Cedar County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE: The purpose of this ordinance is to establish election precincts for Cedar County to comply with current laws due to the 2010 federal decennial census.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS: For use in this ordinance, the following terms or words shall be interpreted or defined as follows:

3. "Voting Precinct" or "Precinct" shall mean a county or municipal subdivision for casting and counting votes in elections.
4. "Township" shall mean a civil and political subdivision of the county.

SECTION 3. ELECTION PRECINCTS: Cedar County shall have twelve (12) election precincts established and defined as follows:

PRECINCT NAME

Cass/ Center/ Iowa/ Rochester	All of Cass Township, Center Township, Iowa Township and Rochester Township
Dayton/ Fairfield -	All of Dayton Township and all of Fairfield Township, including the City of Clarence
Farmington/ Sugar Creek -	All of Farmington Township and all of Sugar Creek Township, including the City of Durant within Cedar County and the City of Wilton within Cedar County
Gower/ Springdale- Fremont/ Red Oak-	All of Gower Township and all of Springdale Township All of Fremont Township and all of Red Oak Township, including the City of Stanwood
Inland -	All of Inland Township, including the City of Bennett
Linn/Pioneer -	All of Linn Township, and all of Pioneer Township, including the City of Mechanicsville
Massillon/Springfield -	All of Massillon Township and Springfield Township, including the City of Lowden
Tipton 1 -	City of Tipton – Precinct #1, per Ordinance 516
Tipton 2 -	City of Tipton – Precinct #2, per Ordinance 516
Tipton 3 -	City of Tipton – Precinct #3, per Ordinance 516
West Branch 1-	City of West Branch within Cedar County

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective on January 15, 2012, after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
