

Courthouse - Tipton, Iowa. March 8th, 1967.

The Cedar County Zoning Board of Adjustment met at the time and place designated above with the following members present: Paul Busching; Lester Chambliss; Ferd Goettsch; Chris Boedeker and Ted Worrall.

A motion was made by Ferd Goettsch and seconded by Lester Chambliss that the present officers, Paul Busching, Chairman, and Ted Worrall, Secretary, be elected to continue in their same offices for the year of 1967. Motion carried.

The main purpose of the meeting was to give consideration to a petition submitted by the Bennett State Bank of Bennett, Iowa, requesting permission to erect an eight foot by sixteen foot illuminated sign, same to be located in Inland Township, Cedar County, near the southwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, at the intersection of Highway 150 and H Road. Owner of said location being Mr. Lester Pechenschneider of New Liberty, Iowa, and lease on said property being held by aforementioned Bennett State Bank.

A motion was made by Ferd Goettsch and seconded by Chris Boedeker that the request of the Bennett State Bank as set forth in their petition be approved and granted. A roll call vote resulted as follows:
