The Cedar County Zoning Commission held a Special Meeting at the Courthouse in the City of Tipton, Iowa, at 10:00 AM. The meeting was presided over by Chairman Loeffler. Present were Commission members Busching, Loeffler, Voss, Chambliss, Suchomel, and Zoning Administrator Dvorak. Absent was Commission member Worrall. Also present at the meeting were Mr. Louis Schroeder and Mrs. Gary Green.

The purpose of the meeting was to review survey plat of three lots adjacent to Highway 130 just east of Bennett as presented for approval by Mr. Schroeder. The question of access roads to the lots came up for considerable discussion since these would be directly off Highway 130. In view of the fact that the State Highway Commission placed no restrictions on the access roads, and the plat submitted conformed to Subdivision Ordinance for Cedar County, motion was made by Busching, seconded by Voss, to approve survey plat as submitted. Motion carried unanimously.

The minutes of the November 12, 1974, Public Hearing were read. Motion was made by Busching, seconded by Voss, to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

It was also agreed to dispense with the regular December meeting of the Commission unless new and further business was to come before the Commission requiring a regular December meeting.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, upon motion by Chambliss, seconded by Suchomel, the meeting adjourned at 10:45 AM.

The Cedar County Zoning Commission held a Public Hearing at the Courthouse in the City of Tipton, Iowa, at 10:00 AM. The hearing was presided over by Chairman Loeffler. Present were Commission members Busching, Loeffler, Voss, Suchomel, and Zoning Administrator Dvorak. Absent were Commission members Chambliss and Worrall.

The minutes of the Oct. 16, 1974, regular meeting were approved as read.

Petition of Delbert Hayes, file #3874, was presented to the Commission. Mr. Hayes was present and requested that a special permit be issued to him for the purpose of operating a junk yard on his property located off the Cedar Valley pavement consisting of a one-half acre site on which he now resides and on which he has been conducting such business. Motion was made by Busching, seconded by Voss, that a temporary permit to operate a junk yard be issued to Mr. Hayes for one year from date of issue, subject to review or renewal by the Commission at the expiration of said period of time. Motion carried unanimously.

The next order of business was to review file #3674 of Twin State Engineering and Chemical Company, represented at the hearing by Mr. R. Hovey Tinsman, Jr. There were no objectors present. A letter from the Durant Chamber of Commerce endorsing this petition was read by the Zoning Administrator. This application had already been considered at the Oct. 16, 1974, regular meeting and, since there were no objections on record, motion was made by Suchomel, seconded by Voss, to grant said petition. Motion carried unanimously.

The Commission then proceeded to review a partial draft of the proposed Zoning Ordinance for Cedar County with Mr. Lee Schoen, Planning and Engineering Consultant. Additional work is to be completed in this area before any action is taken by the Commission.

The Commission also discussed the as yet unpublished Subdivision Regulations for Cedar County. In a motion of concern, introduced by Voss, seconded by Busching, it was suggested that the Zoning Administrator follow through on the lack of publication of the Subdivision Ordinance as previously approved by this Commission on Aug. 13, 1974, and by the Board of Supervisors on Sept. 23, 1974. Motion carried unanimously.

The Mayor of Durant, Mr. Schacht, stated he was authorized to speak for the City Council of Durant and they felt the location of Twin-States in the area under consideration would present no problems of any magnitude for the City of Durant, they would be glad to have Twin-State in the area and it was hoped the proposed petition would meet with the approval of the Zoning Commission. A motion was made by Chambliss, seconded by Voss, to go into executive session, Motion carried unanimously. Procedural methods were then discussed and the Commission returned to regular session. A motion was then made by Chambliss, seconded by Busching, to hold a public hearing on Twin-State's petition. Motion carried unanimously. Mr. Dvorak is to handle matters pertaining to publication of notice to all interested parties.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, upon motion by Suchomel, seconded by Voss, the meeting adjourned at 11:20 AM.

File #1374, application of Melvin Duffy, requesting a change in zoning from A-1 to R-1 was next considered. Motion was made by Busching, seconded by Worrall, to grant said application request. Motion carried unanimously.

The next order of business to be considered was file #1174, petition of Don Dollar to rezone approximately 31 acres from A-1 to R-1. Future land use of this area was personally presented by Mr. Dollar and Mr. Link Martin, subject to approval by the Zoning Commission of Mr. Dollar's application. Upon consideration by the Commission, motion was made by Chambliss, seconded by Worrall, to approve said application. Motion carried unanimously.

The Cedar County Zoning Commission held a meeting at the Courthouse in Tipton, Iowa, at 2:00 PM. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Loeffler. Present were members Loeffler, Suchomel, Busching, Chambliss, Voss, and Zoning Administrator Dvorak. Absent was Commission member Worrall.

The minutes of the April 5, 1974, meeting were approved as read.

The first part of the meeting was spent in considering application #874 of John Paul Wentz, Route #1, West Branch, for permission to rezone a 5-acre tract in Gower Township from A-1 to R-1. Motion was made by Busching, seconded by Suchomel to turn application down on the basis that soil conservation maps submitted indicated severe limitations for a sewer system to the majority of the property with moderate limitations on the remainder, a seasonally high water table, poor drainage, that property was subject to flooding and had a marginal percolation rate; also, that a change in zoning classification could be considered spot zoning. Motion carried unanimously.

The second part of the meeting centered on a discussion of regular monthly meetings of the Commission. Motion was made by Voss, seconded by Chambliss, that the Cedar County Zoning Commission meet regularly on the third ^{wed.} ~~Thursday~~ of each month, commencing with the month of June, 1974. Time of the meetings shall be 10:00 AM at the Courthouse. Motion carried unanimously.

The third part of the meeting was attended by Mr. Lee Schoon and consisted of reviewing draft of Subdivision Ordinance for Cedar County, Sections 5 through 6, as prepared by Mr. Schoon. Motion was made by Chambliss, seconded by Busching, that Subdivision Ordinance, Sections 1 through 6, be presented by Mr. Schoon to the Cedar County Board of Supervisors for their consideration and further handling. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, upon motion made by Chambliss, seconded by Voss, the meeting adjourned at 4:00 PM.
