Discussion was held on IPERS classification codes for elected officials. In January 2022 IPERS issued a memo requesting that counties update the classification of elected officials to a newly created category within their system. This change has created an issue with retirement from other employment. IPERS has since confirmed that elected officials may be classified as either full-time or part-time. Reclassifying Supervisors as part-time elected officials would allow them the option to decline IPERS coverage. This change has been reviewed by HR Attorney Galloway and Wellmark and would not affect county provided health and dental benefit eligibility. The Handbook does not currently reflect this and will need to be changed.

Barnhart to approve the classification code change for supervisor elected officials and update the handbook to say Salaried elected officials (including supervisors, Auditor, Treasurer, Recorder, Sheriff and County Attorney) are considered full-time employees for the purpose of county benefit eligibility, regardless of IPERS classification of scheduled hours worked.
