Director Petersen updated the board on the Massillon campground update. The electric water and site posts have all been put in. In the next week the gravel pads and road will be put down. The electric still needs to be inspected before it can be turned on. We are hoping to have the project completed by Memorial Day Weekend.

Director Petersen informed the board that he had applied for and received a grant from Quad Cities Community Foundation to help offset the cost of the new body cameras.

Discussed using the My County Parks website administered by Iowa County Conservation Board System, for online payment of campsites and payment and reservation of the new Bennett cabin. Hartwig moved to table so more information and discussion could be had Rouse seconded motion carried.
