PUBLIC COMMENTS: None

Director Petersen updated the board on the Bennett cabin project the structure is closed in, windows and roof are on, the siding is partially completed, and the heating system is scheduled to be installed tomorrow.

Director Petersen updated the board on the fish kill on Bennett Pond. The kill was severe with most of the fish dying off. The main contributing factors were heavy rain-washing nutrients into the pond high temperatures which caused a large algae bloom.

Director Petersen updated the board on the Rusty Patch Bumblebee survey. Over 60 Bees were Identified but no Rusty Patch bees were located. All the data can be viewed on the Bumble Bee Watch webpage.

Director Petersen updated the board on the approximately 20 acres of land donated to the county by the Lee Beine estate. The Beine estate has turned over the deed, and the property is now owned and managed by the county. Discussion was had about signage and connecting existing trails at Rock creek timber to the Beine Tract in the future.
