OUR SERVICES...

Skilled Nursing Services

**Provided under the supervision of a Primary Care Provider.*

- \$150/visit
- Home safety evaluations and training
- Medication management/instruction
- Wound care management and ostomy care
- Catheter care
- Health observation, assessment, and monitoring (i.e. blood pressure, temperature, pulse, etc.)
- Laboratory blood draws
- Health education and assistance to understand a diagnosis or treatment
- IV therapy
- Specimen collection
- Injections
- 24-hour on call

Home Health Aide Services

- \$50/hour-prorated
- Assistance with activities of daily living such as bathing, dressing, hair care, skin care
- Application of elastic stockings
- Assistance with transfers and ambulation
- Assistance with rehabilitation and exercise therapy
- Medication reminders

Rehabilitation Services

- \$180/visit
- Physical Therapy through contracted therapists

Homemaker Services

- \$40/hour-prorated
- Light housekeeping
- Household organization
- Meal preparation
- Laundry assistance
- Essential errands

Respite Services

- \$50/hour-prorated
- Scheduled, non-medical visits lasting one to six hours
- Provide temporary relief from the demands of caregiving
- Provide appropriate care and supervision to protect a person's safety in the absence of the caregiver
- Funding for this service is available through Heritage Area Agency on Aging or Veterans Administration. Clients may also pay privately.

Loan Closet

**Some medical equipment is available for loan, at no cost, to Cedar County residents, based upon availability.*

- Walkers
- Canes
- Crutches
- Commodes
- Bath seats/benches
- Stool risers
