

Frequently Asked Questions

COVID-19 VACCINE PHASE 1B

What is the current process for Cedar County Public Health (CCPH) to get vaccine out into the community?

- CCPH is working with four Cedar County Partners to address the current list of our age population eligible for the vaccine (ages 65 and older).

Mercy Family Services and UnityPoint Health in Cedar County will be contacting their patients who are currently eligible for the vaccine based off their age. The amount vaccine they are receiving from us weekly is very small. *Please do not call their office to schedule as they will reach out to their patients when they have vaccine available.*

The Tipton Wal-Mart Pharmacy and Tipton Pharmacy are distributing vaccine using the list provided by CCPH for those age 65 and older who are eligible. Once this list is complete we will announce the process to schedule. Please do not call the pharmacies.

What if I doctor in another county and I do not receive my prescriptions from the two pharmacies you are partnering with?

- CCPH will work with the two pharmacies we have identified as our partners to open up appointments to individuals in the future once we work through our current list. Please do not call them at this time as they are working through names that have been provided to them.

Is there a waiting list?

- There is not a waiting list. We ask for your patience and grace as we work through the names we already have. Once that is complete we will announce the plan of how and when you can register for an appointment.
